A single tool for Organisations, Managers and Administration

1 Plan

See which vessels are currently in port and any that are on route using real time AIS data from Marine Traffic.

Be prepared for the day ahead by creating a visit schedule or to do list within the app.



2 Deliver

Check in and out of each vessel and easily report on your visit. Quickly document the important stories from your visit and easily add the hard numbers on the services you provided.

Think a picture would help explain a report? Multiple photos can be attached to each report you publish.

No more lengthy hand written reports at the end of the week or month, capture data on the move as you're visiting.





3 Report

Produce detailed reports for all visits by your staff, or focus on a port, a vessel or a specific ship visitor.

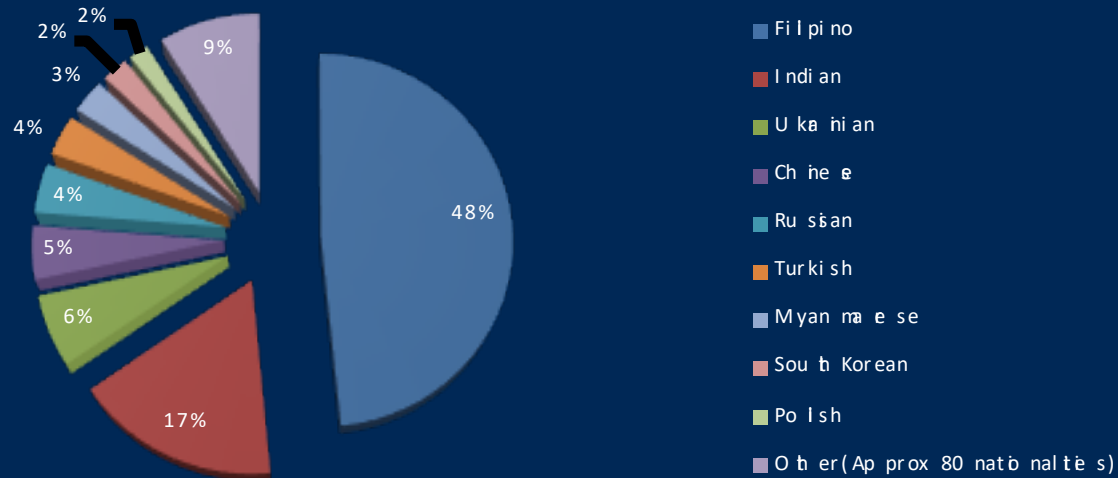
Gain real time insights in to your organisations effectiveness and better understand the services that your team are delivering.

Handle long running welfare cases than span ports or vessels, collating information in a single actionable place.



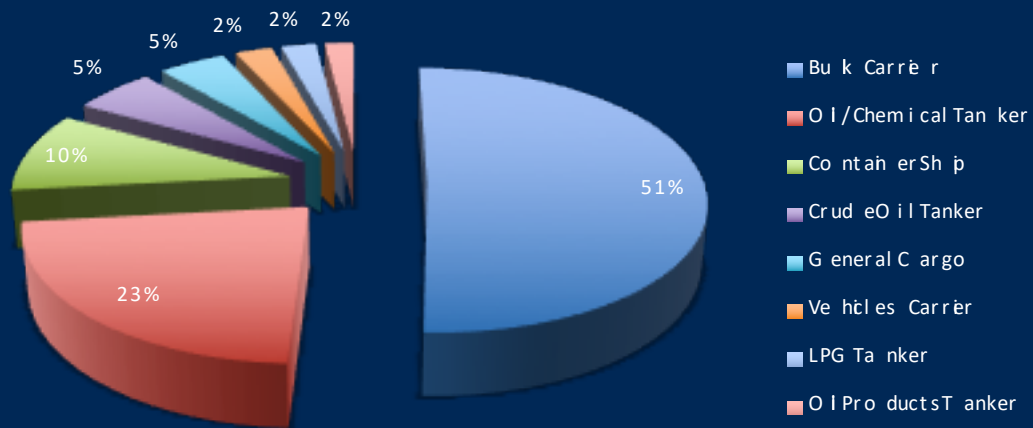


Marshall Islands - Crew Nationalities





Marshall Islands - Ship Types



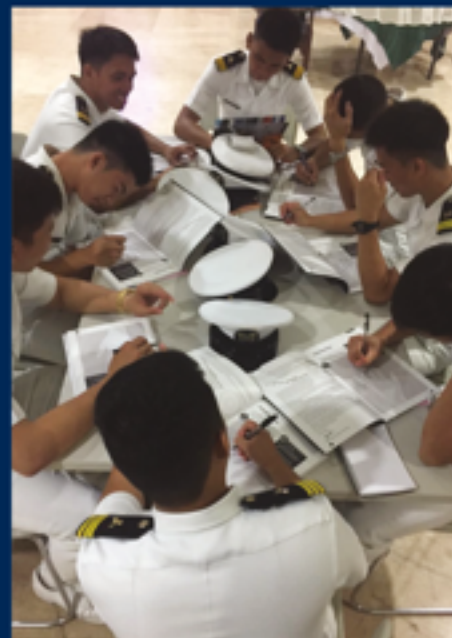
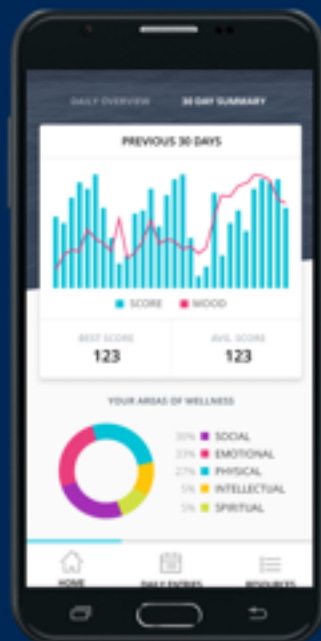
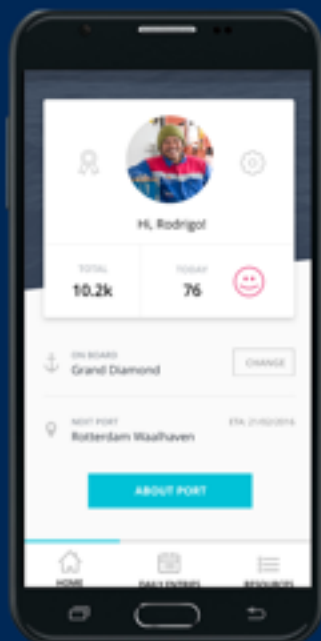


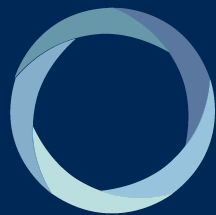
