Subject: ELIMINATION OF REQUIREMENT FOR MULTIPLE LOAD LINE

ASSIGNMENT BOOK

Date: 17 January 2025

Effective January 2025, the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) Maritime Administrator (the "Administrator") no longer requires the use and carriage of an RMI Multiple Load Line Assignment Book (MLLAB).

Going forward, Masters must record changes of freeboard in the vessel's Deck Log Book, without an attending Recognized Organization (RO) Surveyor.

No new RMI MLLAB will be issued from January 2025. If a vessel has an existing RMI MLLAB, it should no longer be used but must be maintained onboard for the required three-year period.
